kohsla'kekha' áht <u>a</u> '	winter boots
kohsla'kekha' aná:lo:l <u>e</u> '	winter hat
kohsla'kekha' a'nyá:naw∧	winter mitts or gloves
kohsla'kekha' a'nhuskwá:lh <u>a</u> '	winter (snow) pants
kohsla'kekha' anihtyákt <u>a</u> '	winter scarf



## Getting Dressed: Outside Clothing A1 - Speaking to 1 person
